Harrington and the former Mayor John Yunits, with full support of the Brockton City Council, a decision was made to proceed with an expanded, comprehensive plan to save this historic, architectural treasure for the use and benefit of all of the citizens of Brockton. This effort has been designated as the **War Memorial Restoration Project**, and is a collaborative effort of the Brockton War Memorial Foundation, the Kenneth Feinberg Foundation and the **Project Steering Committee**.
